## YOUR JUDGES

### DOGS : MR DUSKO PILJEVIC (GALLINAGOS)

I have always liked Cocker, I got my first one in 1990, a lovely black puppy bitch...A few Dog Shows were visited, but without much success. But by now I had decided that showing and breeding the most beautiful dogs as possible, would be my goal in life... In 1994, my first show quality black bitch came into my life and we became a great team winning well and developing our craft in the show ring and learning from each other... While studying at The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in 1996, I met my future wife Bobana, a great person who supported me in every way, especially to start a serious breeding program, to achieve my goal. We moved in to a not so big house, but with huge garden; we made our small world where we live in love and peace with our cats and dogs. We made perfect place for GALLINAGOS English Cocker Spaniels and Norwegian Forest Cats. GALLINAGOS kennel was founded in 1997. And up to the present day we have produced 27 litters. Many of them became Champions of countries all around the World and 12 became International and Multi Champions. Some of them even managed to achieve European and World Champion titles, which made me very, very proud. I'm specially proud that all dogs from my breeding that have been shown in UK, Have always been placed at both CRUFT's and The Cocker Club Championship Show.

I had always preferred breeding and showing dogs, to judging them. But I realized I could do something more for the breed by judging dogs - who are not bred by us...and found it so exciting to try to find the best one and the one closest to the breed standard...

So I decided to become FCI judge and I successfully passed exams...so since 1998 I have been judging ALL BREEDS in VIII FCI Group. Two years later I passed more exams to become an INTERNATIONAL FCI JUDGE for ALL BREEDS in VIII FCI Group. I have judged at National, International and Specialized Shows in Germany, Austria, Italy, Slovenia, Belgium, Czech Republic, Poland, Lithuania, Russia and of course in Serbia.

Judging Dogs at Scottish Championship Show is great honour for me and I'm really looking forward to it.

### BITCHES: MRS KIM GAIN (MOLKARA)

I would like to thank the committee for offering me this appointment, my 1st at this level.

I have been involved with Cocker Spaniels since 1993 when I purchased a little black bitch who was to be a family pet.

I took her to an exemption show where she won "Dog with the waggiest tail" ironic really as she had the shortest dock! Nevertheless I was hooked.

My affix Molkara was born in 1995 & was an amalgamation of my 1st two Cocker bitches, Molly & Kara.

Since then I have owned & bred numerous Cockers which have been shown with varying degrees of success.

I have been fortunate enough to have made up four Show Champions in that time, two of which were home-bred. I have bred & exhibited several other solids & Particolours with CC's and RCC's to their names. Other exhibitors with my breeding have gained JWs, ShCMs, Stud Book Numbers & RCCs.

One of my dogs was also Dog World/Royal Canin Top Cocker Stud Dog in 2006 & 2007.

I have also sent a home-bred golden boy who won the Post Graduate class at Crufts, before going out to the Czech Republic where he has been campaigned successfully to the title of International Champion.

The pinnacle of my show career so far was to have won BIS at the prestigious Cocker Club Championship show in 2004, with my lovely boy Sh Ch Claramand Rock N Roll with Molkara JW.

I have judged overseas in Serbia, Finland & Montenegro at Cocker Spaniel Specialties.

I have owned both Solid & Particoloured Cockers & look forward to judging your dogs & meeting you all.

BREEDERS' COMPETITION

The Breeders' Competition offers the following Awards.

**Best Breeder in Breed/AVNSC classes 1st, 2nd and 3rd**

**Best Breeder in Group 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th**

**Grand Final at Crufts 2013**

The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders' Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team.
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award
5. The Breeder's team must consist of a minimum of three and a maximum of four dogs of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed and Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Breeders acquire points in competition over a calendar year as follows.

Best Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	3 points
Second place Breeder In Breed/AVNSC Classes	2 points
Third place Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	1 point
Best Breeder in Group	4 points
Second place Breeder In Group	3 points
Third place Breeder in Group	2 points
Fourth place Breeder in Group	1 point

The Breeders who have amassed a minimum of 25 points over a calendar year will qualify for the Final/Semi Final in the following year. It is not a requirement to withdraw from the competition upon reaching 25 points. At the end of the competition year in question, Breeders should forward their record books to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club which will advise whether they have qualified for the Crufts Final
