

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A 42.
(a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there at.
(b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
(2a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present at any time during the Show.
(b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
(a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
(c) The shortening of tails of customarily docked breeds but only up to an acceptable age limit which shall be prescribed from time to time.
(d) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.
Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the K.C. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

Directions to Venue

Leave M5 at Jct 20 towards Clevedon, At Roundabout take exit B3133. At next roundabout take 1st exit on to Central Way. At next roundabout take 1st exit on to Kenn Road, follow road along and turn left into Davis Lane. Cross over motorway and the Hand Stadium is on your Right. Ignore the 1st entrance, please use next entrance including disabled.

PLEASE KEEP CONTROL OF CHILDREN

It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to control their children as any damage caused on the Showground could jeopardise future bookings. an Exhibitor whose child is found causing damage or nuisance will be refused entry at future shows. Any breach of the above will result in the Parent/Person in charge being requested to remove the child from the show forthwith.

- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.

- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

18. Not for Competition: Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.

19. The show will be held under Kennel Club Rules & Show Regulations. All dogs must be registered or transferred in accordance with Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.

20. The Committee shall not be held responsible for exhibitors missing their classes.

21. Exhibitors passes and exhibitors numbers will not be sent. A stamped addressed postcard may be enclosed if acknowledgement of entry is required.

22. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his or her engagement, the committee reserve the right to appoint another judge or judges in their place. Exhibitors may withdraw from competition but no entry fee can be returned.

23. You are required to clear up any fouling by your dog. Any infringement of this regulation will be reported to the show manager who will take such actions as is seen fit.

24. The Committee will be empowered to exclude or remove any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from illness, disease, vice, Natural or other causes, and if such an exclusion takes place, either before or after judging, the entry fee will be forfeited.

25. The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of all dogs entered for exhibition and for any property entrusted to it. But it must be clearly understood by exhibitors and any other persons that the committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or detention of, or damage to any dog or person for any cause what whatsoever, not for any act of omission or themselves, their officers, servants, agents and others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.

26. The committee of the show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations of dogs for Exhibition (K.C.S.R.(f)).

27. No Animal other than a dog duly entered at this show will be allowed within the precincts of the show except by permission of the committee.

28. All persons attending the show must compensate and/or indemnify the society for any loss or damage to any property or buildings within the Showground caused with or without negligence by any person under the age of 18 years who is brought by them to the show or for whom they are responsible.
